To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$10,890.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services from the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to the Salaries and Wages Account. The Cambridge Housing Authority and the Department of Human Service Programs have entered into an agreement, funded by the Department of Housing and Urban Development to provide residents of Cambridge public housing slots in the Community Schools after school and summer camp programs. Funds will be used to pay the part time instructors who work at the sites. Funds were originally appropriated in the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account, however, expenses are salary related, therefore funds need to be transferred to the Salary and Wages Account.
