WHEREAS:

St. Francis of Assisi Parish in East Cambridge has notified the Cambridge School Committee that it will discontinue operation of the parochial school known as St. Francis of Assisi Parochial School and

WHEREAS:

The Cambridge School Committee will have to absorb Cambridge resident pupils of the aforementioned parochial school, which will necessitate the leasing of the building now occupied by said parochial school subject to approval of the City Council and the School Committee, and

WHEREAS:

Additional expenditures will have to be borne by the School Committee for the operation of this building which expenses could not have been foreseen at the time the 1969 budget was promulgated. Therefore, it is

ORDERED:

That the City Manager recommend to the City Council prior to the setting of the tax rate, the following supplementary School Department budget:
