To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting a transfer of \$4,000 in the General Fund from the Reserve Account to the Historical Commission Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. Funds will be used to support the publication of a self-guided walking tour map of American Revolution sites in Cambridge. This map will be distributed to visitors and Cambridge citizens beginning on Saturday, July 1, 2000, as a part of the Revolutionary Cambridge Discovery Day, which is being organized by the Historic Cambridge Collaborative. The event will commemorate the 225th anniversary of the start of the American Revolution in 1775 and George Washington's arrival in Cambridge. Map distribution sites include among others, the information booth at Harvard Square, all library branches, the Historical Commission office and the Cambridge Historical Society.
