

Cambridge, October 26 1867

To the Honorable, the City Council,
of the City of Cambridge.

The undersigned respectfully pray that
West Boston Bridge may be made
more safe and convenient for the trav-
elling public, by removing the sidewalks
on one side (or both if thought best),
and building one outside of the present
railing, and having the Rail Road tracks
removed to one side; by so doing to
leave a good street for carriages with-
out causing them to cross and recross
the tracks, and settle the vexed ques-
tion of removing the snow from the
tracks, as no one would object if they
could have a street that was safe.
Believing that something should be done
by the City to accommodate the large
portion of our citizens who travel in the
Horse Cars and at the same time not to en-
danger the life and property of those who
travel in their own teams is the object of
this petition.
