Re: Funding before Congress

I am reporting to you on what I learned at the National League of Cities Board meeting with regard to federal funding of programs which Cambridge uses.

Presently before the Congress are proposals to:

Add \$200 million to the Community Development Block grant. There is also, however, discussion of some of that money not coming directly to cities.

Add \$200 million to the HOME program, a program we are presently using for some housing purposes.

Add \$500 million to jobs' programs.

Add \$500 million to Headstart (voted in the House)

There is no increase in discretionary spending, however. These are all reallocations.
