To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$166,062.41 in the Grant Fund from the Department of Public Welfare through the Greater Boston Adult Shelter Alliance (GBASA) to the Human Services Department Salary & Wages Account \$61,342.41 and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$104,720.00. The purpose of the funding is to supplement and extend current available emergency resources to eligible homeless persons. The services will include placing additional 24 emergency shelter beds both at the YMCA and YWCA. Twenty-two of the shelter beds will be located at the YMCA and 2 shelter beds at the YWCA.
