To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am pleased to report that Polaroid Corporation and the CambridgeSide Galleria have agreed to allow residents to use their premises, as detailed below, for parking and storing automobiles during declared snow emergencies.

The Polaroid Corporation is allowing Cambridge residents use of the parking lot located behind 784 Memorial Drive. This parking lot can be accessed off Pleasant Street. Although I encourage automobile owners to use this lot during declared snow emergencies, I need to caution residents that the City is not responsible for damage or theft.

Residents can also use the garage at the CambridgeSide Galleria in East Cambridge during declared snow emergencies. The driver needs to take a ticket when entering the garage between 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m. The garage is closed from 1:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. The procedure while exiting is as follows: the driver must take the ticket to the Customer Service Desk on level 1 of the mall and ask for the Manager on Duty; the desk is open from 10:00 a.m. to 9:30 p.m. The Manager will verify eligibility by checking the driver's license for a Cambridge address and will then validate the ticket for a free exit. If the Customer Service Desk is closed (9:30 p.m. to 10:00 a.m.), the driver needs to take the ticket to the Security Office and ask for the Security Supervisor. The Supervisor will verify eligibility and validate the ticket. This program will be in effect through the end of March, as long as parking spaces are available in the garage.

I would like to, once again, thank Polaroid Corporation and the CambridgeSide Galleria for their cooperative approach in assisting Cambridge in this matter.
