WHEREAS: On September 22, 1997, the City Council unanimously adopted an order requesting the City Manager to provide results of the City's inquiry of employees who live outside the city and send their children to Cambridge Public Schools; and

WHEREAS: That same order also asked the City Manager to instruct the City Council if there was a mechanism in place for the city to recoup tuition costs incurred by students fraudulently attending Cambridge Public Schools; and

WHEREAS: The City Council has yet to receive this information; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report to the City Council what action will be taken against any City of Cambridge employees who have been found to have fraudulently enrolled children in their custody in Cambridge Public Schools; and it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report to the City Council what action will be taken to recoup tuition costs expended on children fraudulently attending Cambridge Public Schools, costs that were incurred by Cambridge taxpayers; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Law Department to propose an ordinance prohibiting the act of fraudulently enrolling children in Cambridge Public Schools, complete with penalties for violations; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to provide this information to the City Council at the December 22, 1997 meeting of the City Council.

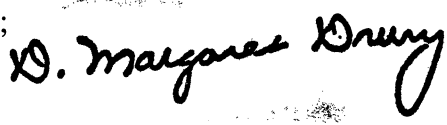
