In Board of Aldermen, June 1th 1859-

Ordered, Whereas in and by an Order of this Board, bearing date the sixth day of April last; the abutments on Thoncliffe Street, between Third and Sixth Streets, were directed to remove forthwith all encroachments upon said Thoncliffe Street, standing in front of their respective estates; and whereas the same cannot, in many instances, be removed without serious inconvenience and great expense to said abutments; and whereas said removals may be made with less inconvenience and expense, whenever alterations or repairs shall be made upon said estates:

Ordered,

That the time for the removal of the said encroachments be and is hereby extended, until such time as alterations or repairs shall be made upon said estates, or until notice to remove the same shall be given by this Board.
