IN CITY COUNCIL

September 8, 1997

ORDERED: That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Central Square World's Fair for four banners across Massachusetts Avenue at various locations, Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Provided that, before erecting the above named banners the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a bond in the sum of Eight Thousand (\$8,000.00) Dollars, conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the installation, maintenance and use of said banners.

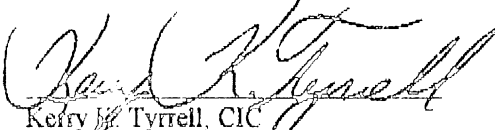

Dear Ralph,

This letter is to confirm the details of the DPW's assistance on the day of the Central Square World's Fair on Sunday, September 21, 1997 (rain date: September 28, 1997).

WORLD'S FAIR BANNERS: We would like to have all banners (4) across Mass. Ave. by Friday, September 5th. The four locations are as follows:

1. Across Mass. Ave. in front of the Middle East facing Boston.
2. Across Mass. Ave. in front of Libby's Liquors facing Harvard.
3. Across Mass. Ave. in front of The Tobias Building facing Boston.
4. Across Mass. Ave. in front of City Hall facing Harvard.

All banners will be delivered the DPW by Friday, August 20th.

STREET CLOSINGS: Mass. Ave. will be closed at 9am. All side streets will be closed at 7am.

STAGES: We would like to use both the City's platform stages (16' x 16' each, set up on the standard 4" pipe scaffolding you usually use). These will need to be set up beginning at 9am, when Mass. Ave. will be closed by traffic personnel. One stage goes at the eastern side of Inman St. and the other goes just to the east of Brookline Street, also on Mass. Ave. (See enclosed Map). I will be doing a site inspection with Fred Cabral regarding exact position of both stages.

DUMPSITES: As we discussed at the City Hall meeting, we would like a trash truck on Douglas Street as well as a dumpster on Essex Street behind the Kids Stage.

CARDBOARD BARRELS WITH PLASTIC LINERS: We would like as many as possible. A lot of strong replacement liners will help the volunteers to keep Mass. Ave. clean. The food vendors will be instructed to keep their own trash bagged and transported to either the dumpster or truck.

ELECTRICAL POWER: All stages will need electricity. I've discussed locations with Warren as well as the amount of power needed.
