WHEREAS: Tax assistance will be available to the Main Branch of the Cambridge Library on April 6 & 13 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., the East End House on April 2 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. by appointment only, and at the Senior Center on April 9 from 2:00 p.m. to 4:15 p.m. for seniors by appointment; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to make every effort to publicize these critical tax assistance opportunities to the residents of Cambridge, including running information on tax preparation assistance as a public service announcement on the municipal cable.
