Be it ordained by the City Council of

Sec. 4 of the "Ordinance in addition to the  
Ordinance relating to Accounts and Finance"  
is hereby amended, by inserting after the  
word "bridges" in the fourteenth line thereof,  
the words from assessments for raising and  
improving low lands; and by adding after  
the word "Board" in the last line, the  
words and the receipt of said Board  
shall be a sufficient voucher for all  
monies thus paid over by the Treasurer.
