WHEREAS: Art Yeomelakis of Cambridge scored the winning goal for Providence College in their 4-3 semifinal victory over Boston College on Thursday, March 28, 1985 in the NCAA National Hockey Tournament at the Joe Louis Arena in Detroit, Michigan; and

WHEREAS: Art, who developed his winning ways as a hockey team member and 1982 graduate of Matignon High School and who had an assist earlier in the game, scored at 0:33 of the third overtime to end one of the longest games in tournament history; and

WHEREAS: Although the Providence team lost a close 2-1 decision to Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in the championship game, their final record of 23 wins, 17 losses and 5 ties, along with their championship of the Hockey East Tournament, represents an extremely successful 1984-1985 season in which Art Yeomelakis played an integral part; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record congratulating Art Yeomelakis on scoring the winning goal in triple overtime for Providence College in the NCAA semifinal hockey game, commend him and his teammates for an outstanding 1984-1985 season, and express our sincerest best wishes for continued success in the future.

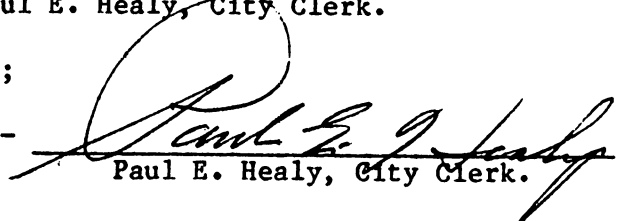
