An Ordinance
establishing the compensation of the officers
and Members of the Fire Department.

Be it ordained by the City Council of
the City of Cambridge, as follows:-

Sec. 1. The officers and Members of the
Fire Department shall severally receive
for their services the following sums, viz:-

Sec. 2. The Chief and Assistant Engineers and their Clerk shall be paid quarterly, the Engineers and Drivers of steamers monthly, all others semi-annually.

Sec. 3. The Chief Engineer shall be authorized to keep a horse in the stable of the Engine House nearest to his residence, or his place of business, as he may from time to time elect, said horse to be provided by and to be the property of the Chief Engineer, and to be for his own use, but to be kept and shod at the expense of the City.

Sec. ³~~4~~. This Ordinance shall take effect as of the first Monday in January last.
