In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 02-22, regarding a report on increased incidents of graffiti in West Cambridge, please be advised of the following:

Both the Day and Night Shift Commanders of the Police Department have been directed to assign extra attention in the West Cambridge area due to graffiti incidents. The Department records indicate that there have been four reports of graffiti this year in the West Cambridge area. The Police Department maintains a database on reports of graffiti incidents, which includes locations, notes and pictures of tags, etc. This database is also utilized to identify patterns and perpetrators. There has been one arrest for a graffiti incident that occurred in the West Cambridge area.
