MAYOR DANEHY

- WHEREAS: The concept of a Sister Cities relationship has encouraged hundreds of cities to become aware both socially and academically of the traditions and lifestyles of cities all over the world, and
- WHEREAS: Cambridge, Massachusetts and Cambridge, England have always enjoyed an informal Sister Cities relationship in the form of exchanges of academics and cordial receptions given on both sides of the Atlantic to past Mayors of Cambridge and their families, and
- WHEREAS: Much can be achieved socially, culturally and politically by residents of Cambridge, Massachusetts through the establishment of a formal Sister Cities relationship with Cambridge, England, and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Ernest Kay of the International Biographical Centre, Cambridge, England has chosen Cambridge, Massachusetts as the site for his 6th International Congress to be held at the Hyatt-Regency Hotel on July 9-15, 1979, and
- WHEREAS: Over four hundred people representing the fifty states and 40-50 various countries of the world will be in attendance, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City of Cambridge, Massachusetts enter into a formal Sister Cities relationship with Cambridge, England; and that the beginning of our long relationship commence with a ceremony that will take place on July 10, 1979 at the Hyatt-Regency Hotel.
