Certain doctors have been using offices at Cambridge Hospital to see private patients over the past year and a half without payment of rent to the City of Cambridge; now therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager be respectfully requested to have leases drawn with said doctors retroactive to the day they began using the offices, with a plan worked out for back payments over a six (6) month period, all leases to be signed by June 1, 1987 with rents to be paid on a regular monthly basis as of that date and if no plan is worked out then an appropriate deduction shall be made from salary.
