RESOLVED:

That the City of Cambridge, Massachusetts, U.S.A., hereby resolves to request the appropriate officials of Paraguay to make public the reasons for the arrest of Alfredo Boccia, Felino Amarilla, and Jose Ignacio Ferreira, and Luis Manuel Guanes Gondra, and to advise whether the right of these persons are being observed under the United National Universal Declaration of Human Rights. As elected government officials in a democratic society, the Cambridge City Councillors wish to say to Paraguayan officials that political activity should never result in the violation of a person's liberty, and further that disregard of the personal rights of members of political opposition creates a destabilizing force in the world.

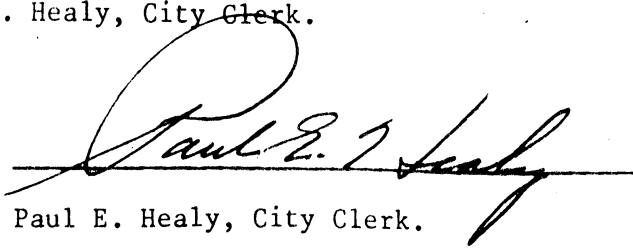

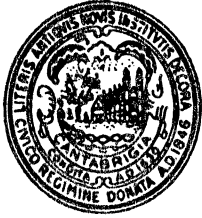

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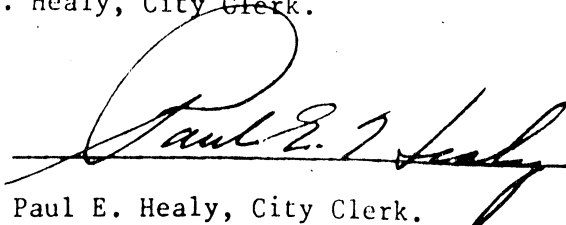
