THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-three

AN ACT FURTHER PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT TO CITIES AND TOWNS OF THE COST
OF INSTALLING CERTAIN SIGNS AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS AT HIGH-ACCIDENT LOCATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court
assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 33B of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
out the first paragraph, as amended by chapter 87 of the acts of 1972, and in-
serting in place thereof the following paragraph:-

The state treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the cost of installing
suitable traffic control signs, or safety devices, and constructing necessary
safety improvements at high-accident locations in cities and towns, in accordance
with the following procedure:.
