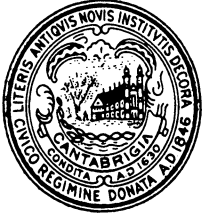



To the Honorable, the City Council,

I do hereby submit for your approval an order establishing an account for the conduct of a Neighborhood Facility Project at the Cambridge Community Center.

This action is pursuant to action taken by the City Council on June 28, 1971, as recommended by me at that time. The total project cost is \$90,000 supported by a \$60,000 capital grant from HUD, \$26,000 from Harvard University and \$4,000 in kind direct service contributions of the City of Cambridge. The project shall be operated pursuant to a revised contract between the City of Cambridge and the Cambridge Community Center, Inc. which was previously authorized.
