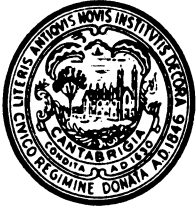
**Subject** City Council Order #16 of May 9, 1989 "Truck Traffic on Washburn Avenue"

The Traffic Department has restricted truck traffic on Washburn Avenue and signs are posted at both ends of the street in Cambridge. The section of Washburn Avenue that is in Somerville is not posted and we have requested them to post their end of the street with truck restriction signs. I will also request the police department to enforce the existing truck restriction regulation.

I will also conduct a speed study as required by state law with a view towards reducing the existing speed limit. As soon as this is completed I will notify you of our findings.

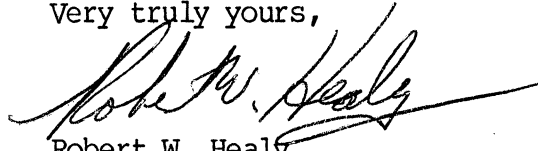
