

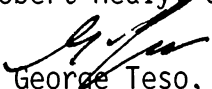

Subject City Council Order #23 dated 5/13/91 Re: Crosswalk at 85 Bp. Allen Drive

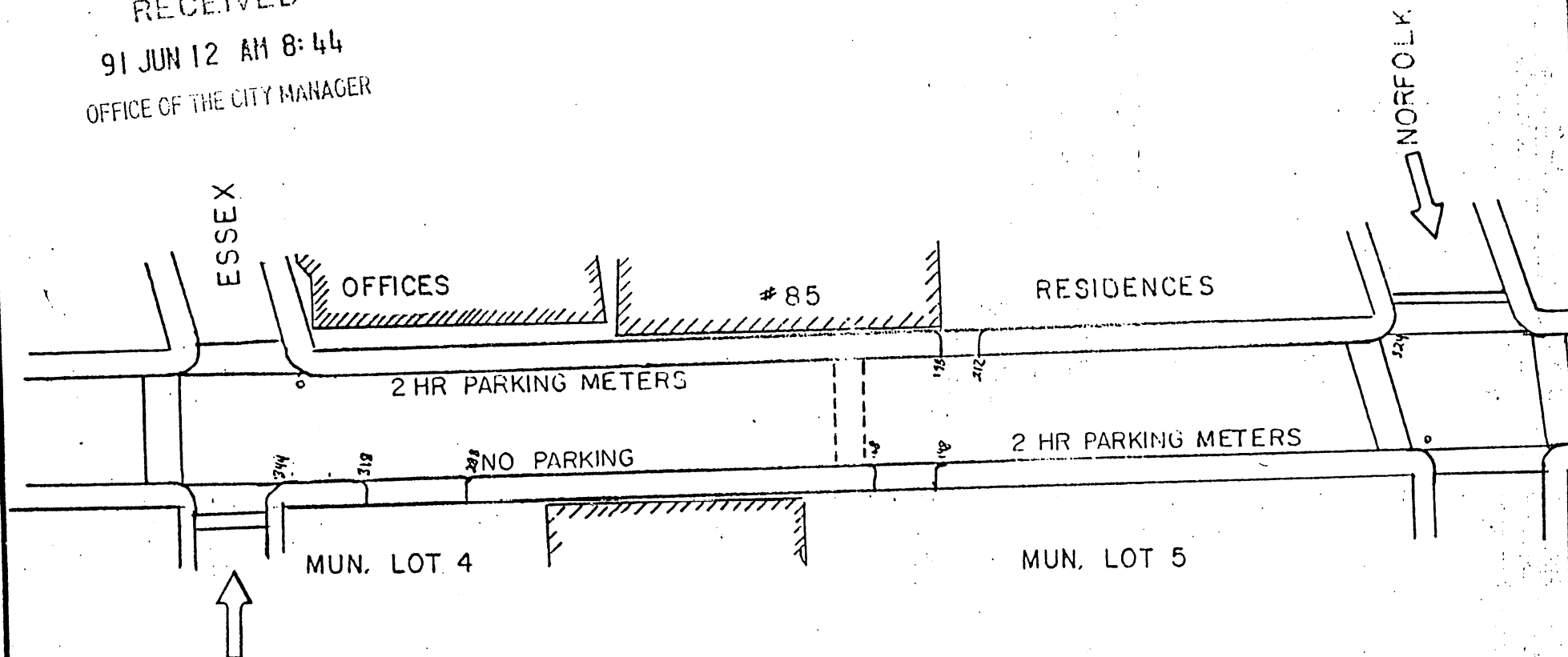
The Traffic and Parking Department has surveyed Bishop Allen Drive from Essex St. to Norfolk St. with a view towards installing mid-block crosswalk at Number 85. It is our opinion that to install a crosswalk at this location where pedestrians have to contend with vehicles entering and leaving the parking lots as well as through traffic would create a safety problem for pedestrians. This block is 300' long with crosswalks located at both Essex St. and Norfolk St. as seen on the enclosed plan. This means that a pedestrian only has to walk 150' to cross at a safer location.

VICE MAYOR REEVES

WHEREAS: The safe passage of children crossing our city's streets is of particular concern to this City Council; and

WHEREAS: When schools are located on busy Cambridge streets it is the general practice to locate a crosswalk in close proximity, to provide safe crossing for the school population; and

WHEREAS: The Henry Buckner School, located at 85 Bishop Allen Drive, is just such a school, with a population of small children who must frequently cross a street filled with heavy traffic; and

WHEREAS: The lack of a crosswalk at this location poses a potential threat to the safety of the school's students; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to consult with the Department of Traffic and Parking on the matter of providing a crosswalk at 85 Bishop Allen Drive and report back to this City Council with a plan for doing so within one week.
