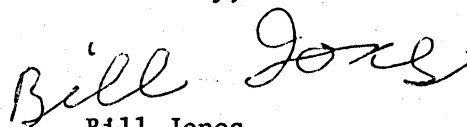
TO: The Honorable, The City Council:
