

1. The name by which the corporation shall be known is:

COMMONWEALTH LODGE 19, I. B. P. O. ELKS OF THE WORLD, INC.

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

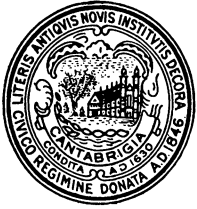
To unite fraternally and foster and cultivate social, educational and business relations of the members and to encourage the promotion and establishment of subsidiary local affiliates. Said lodge may acquire by grant, gift, purchase, devise or bequest, such real and personal property as may be needed to be used in carrying out community, civic, patriotic and social purposes; and to do all things necessary and incidental to and growing out of the foregoing.

To conduct a local unit known as a lodge of the I. B. P. O. Elks of the World, which shall be known as Commonwealth Lodge 19, I. B. P. O. Elks of the World, Inc.

This corporation is not organized for profit of its officers or members, or affiliates, and shall carry out any lawful purpose or object so long as it involves no pecuniary gain or purpose of profit to said members or officers and may dispense such charitable acts as may be determined by a majority of its members.

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

To provide a center for recreational facilities and personal development for the youth of Watertown, and by means of the above to help prevent narcotic addiction by providing socially acceptable alternative activities.

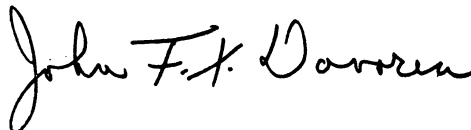

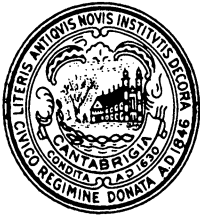
