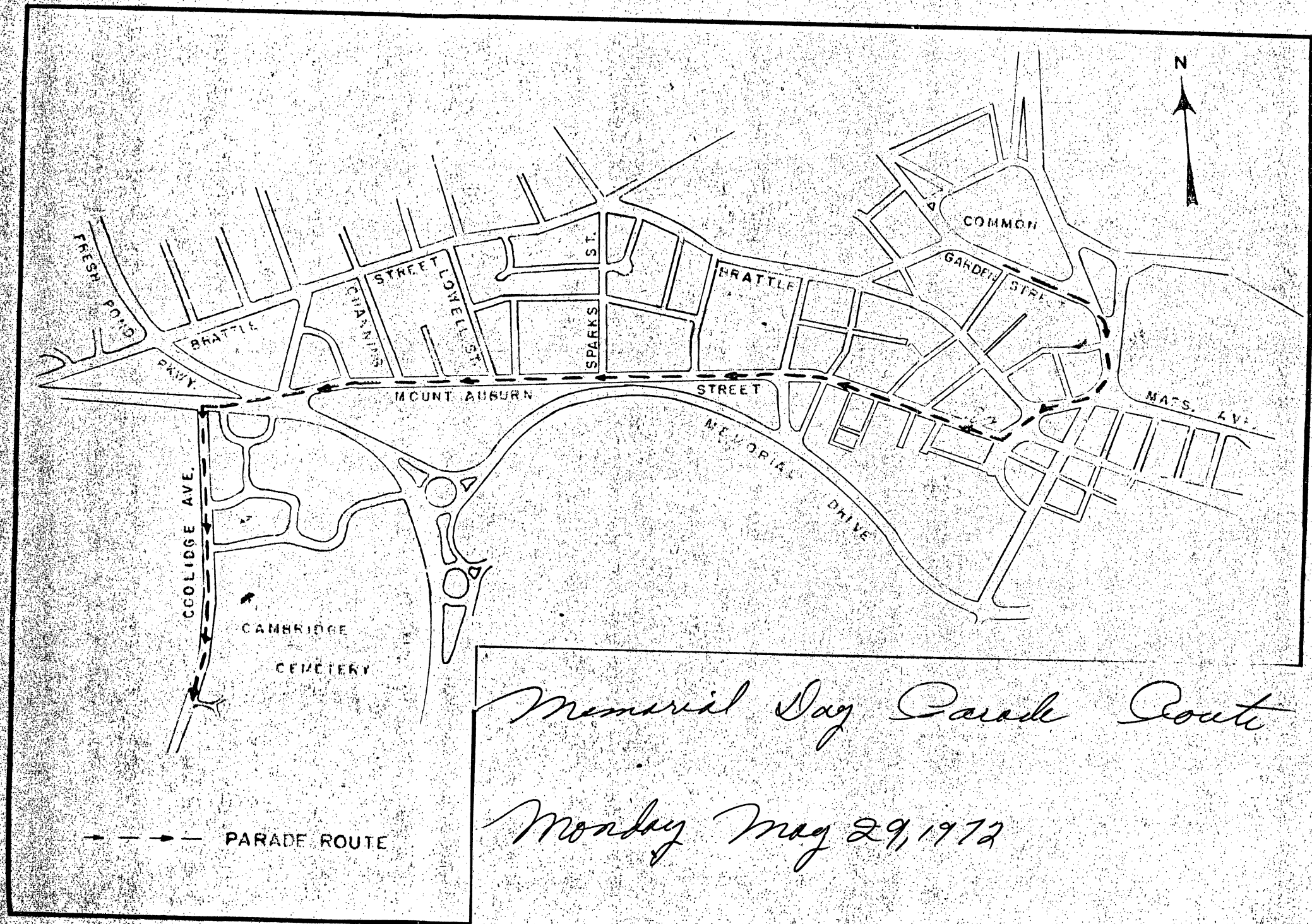
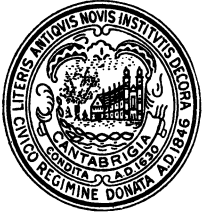

You are cordially invited to participate in our Memorial Day Exercises to be held this year on Monday, May 29, 1972. All participants will assemble at the Cambridge Common on Garden Street at 9:00 A.M.

At 9:30 A.M., a short ceremony will be held at the Old Burying Ground on Massachusetts Avenue and Garden Street. A wreath will be placed in memory of deceased veterans of the War of Independence; firing of volley and taps.

The procession will then proceed from Garden Street to Massachusetts Avenue; right turn onto Brattle Street; bear left to Mount Auburn Street. Follow Mount Auburn Street and take left on Coolidge Avenue to Main Gate of Cambridge Cemetery. Memorial services will be held at the Cambridge Cemetery. The procession will disband at the conclusion of the ceremony at the Cambridge Cemetery.
