- WHEREAS: Oxfam America has also been active in fundraising projects and public awareness of its mission by informing the American people through articles in the press and television public service announcements; and
- WHEREAS: In its dual goals of aid to developing countries and increased public awareness, Oxfam America will hold its fourth "International Harvest Fair" on the Boston Common Saturday and Sunday, September 15 and 16, 1990; and
- WHEREAS: This multicultural fair will be a festival of food, arts and crafts, and international entertainment with participants from the international communities located in the Boston area; and
- WHEREAS: Cambridge has been an active base for Oxfam America activities and continues to support Oxfam's worthy efforts; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council declares September 15 and 16 Oxfam Days and urges Cambridge residents to cross the river to join in this year's multicultural fair on Boston Common; be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to the area officers of Oxfam America to acknowledge their continued efforts for people all over the world.
