The nation's largest youth organization, the Boy Scouts of America, is celebrating its sixtieth year of service to all boys in fulfilling its purpose of promoting "the ability of boys to do things for themselves and others, to train them in Scoutcraft, to teach them patriotism, courage, self-reliance and kindred virtues"; and

Since its founding sixty years ago, the Boy Scouts of American has given over forty-seven million boys a unique foundation for their role as responsible members of our society by emphasis on character development, citizenship training and mental and physical fitness; and

The Boy Scouts of America is completing its first year of a significant long range expansion plan, Boypower "76", the theme of which is "America's manpower begins with boypower", and which will deeply involve a representative one-third of all American boys and help the families and institutions of the nation prepare a new generation of youth with the skill and confidence to master the changing demands of America's future; and

Troop 2 of the Cambridge Council, Boy Scouts of America, sponsored by the North Avenue Congregational Church, has maintained a continuous registration for the entire sixty years of the Scouting movement; and

WHEREAS:-

WHEREAS:-

The City of Cambridge has indeed been the beneficiary of the many fine Scouts and Scouters produced by Troop 2 and the North Avenue Congregational Church, therefore be it
