Petition of the Metropolitan Transit Authority for leave to construct, Maintain and use an alteration of and an addition to existing locations for railway tracks in the City of Cambridge as follows:

Single track loop from and connecting with the easterly or outbound track at a point near the top of the Cambridge Street Subway Incline extending over Cambridge Street and Massachusetts Avenue to and connecting with the westerly or inbound track near the top of said Incline.

Also, that permission be given to establish and maintain the overhead single trolley electric system of motive power in the operation of its cars and said new tracks, and to erect, maintain and use the necessary poles; also wires, appliances and electrical appliances and apparatus and to make the underground and surface alterations of the streets necessary for that purpose.

Upon the foregoing petition the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing at its hearing room, 166 State House, Boston on Tuesday, February 21, 1956 at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon.


