III. Mass Book for 1996: will be ready Thursday, September 14th. Come to the Rectory on this day to request your Masses between 11:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. Weekday Masses will be at 7:00 A.M. Monday through Saturday; the 12:10 Mass will be said on Tuesdays and Wednesdays only; and during Lent Masses will be at 7:00 A.M. and 12:10 every day.

IV. The Sick of the Parish: We would like to list the names of our parishioners who are sick in our Sunday Bulletin, so that we can pray for them. Please call Bernice, Secretary, between 10:30 A.M. and 3:00 P.M. and give the names of the sick to her.

v. In accordance with the Second Vatican Council of 1964 and the Statutes of the Archdiocese of Boston, all Parishes are to have a special place in the Church for the Repository, where the Body and Blood of Jesus is reserved.
