To the Honorable City Council of the City of Cambridge:

The **Middle East Restaurant** respectfully requests that the City Council issue it a permit to post, from 6:00pm to 1:00am on the sidewalk at 472 Massachusetts Avenue, moveable signs not to exceed 2 feet by three feet in dimensions. These signs will direct our customers to a leased parking lot on Norfolk Street behind the Shawmut Bank. The **Middle East Restaurant** has secured private parking upon three (3) lots located on Norfolk Street and the corner of Bishop Allen Drive and Prospect Streets--with 42 parking spaces in one lot and 285 in the other lots, totalling 327 privately secured parking spaces. We understand that city traffic and parking policy does not allow for valet parking to be picked up and dropped off on public streets; therefore two (2) signs are needed in order to direct customers to our private parking lot to park and valet their cars.
