WHEREAS: Spouses of deceased retirees from the employ of the City of Cambridge bear 50% of the cost of continued health benefit coverage provided by the City and, particularly for those on fixed income, this is a very heavy expenditure which has negative fallout in other areas of their lives; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager provide for an assessment of this problem and suggest viable options which would provide for lessening the financial burden without lessening or compromising the assured presence of effective medical coverage; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager file a preliminary report on this matter to this Council by February 12, 1990 and a final synthesis of options by March 19, 1990.
