Proposals for North River Flagging Stone.

Sealed proposals will be received at this office until FRIDAY, March 29th, at 12 o'clock noon, for furnishing the city with about 1900 linear feet (more or less) North River, Belgian Bridge, Flagging stone, the same to be in accordance with the following specifications, viz: Each stone to be not less than six inches in thickness, two feet in width and not less than four nor more than eight feet in length. The sides and ends to be square with the upper surface. The upper surface to be true to line and of straight edges, free from bunches or depressions, and to be in all respects satisfactory to the Committee on Roads and Bridges.

Proposals to state the price per superficial foot. The right is reserved to reject any or all proposals.
