To the Honorable, the City Council of the
City of Cambridge:

The undersigned respectfully pray that ² ⁵ a driveway may be constructed at premises, No. 511 Concord Ave Street, and agrees to deposit with the City Treasurer the sum of twenty-five (25.00) dollars, subject to the following conditions, to wit: In case the amount so deposited is in excess of the cost of the driveway, the difference shall be refunded by the City Treasurer, but in case the cost of the driveway exceeds that deposit, said deposit shall be applied as a credit to the bill and the balance shall be paid to the City Treasurer within thirty days from the receipt of the bill.

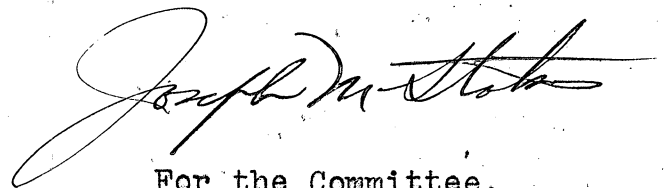
