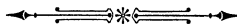

In Board of Aldermen, June 4 1883

The Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges on the part of this Board, which was authorized and directed to enter upon the way leading from Mount Auburn Street, to Gony's Landing, so-called, and in the name and on behalf of the City of Cambridge, to remove any all fences or other obstructions in or upon it, -

Report,

That in accordance with the vote of this board, your Committee visited and entered upon the way aforesaid on the 28th of May last. The Committee went upon the premises, passing through two gateways, and perambulated the said way from Mount Auburn Street to Gony's Landing so-called, and then and there took formal possession of the same, in the name and on behalf of the City of Cambridge. Your Committee asks for further instructions in relation to the matter of said way.
