Water Management Permit Application
Received by the
Water Management Program
for the Charles River Basin

The Department of Environmental Protection will accept written comments on the Water Management permit application recently filed for permitting in the Charles River Basin under the Water Management Act (MGL 21G). Comments will be accepted until April 1, 1998. A copy of the application is available for review from 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday, at DEP's Office of Watershed Management, Boston Office, One Winter Street, Boston, MA (617) 574-6882.

The Franklin Water Department has applied for a permit to add two proposed sources of water supply in the Charles River Basin to their existing registered and permitted sources. No additional withdrawal volume is requested as part of this permit application. Located in Franklin, the new sources are Well #11, located off South Street within the Franklin State Forest in close proximity to wetlands associated with Miscoe Brook, and Well # 12 located off Populatic Street near Populatic Pond, a Great Pond. The new wells are being brought on line to provide system flexibility and to improve the Town's ability to meet peak day demand.

Department records identify Miscoe Brook as a wild and stocked trout stream.
