- WHEREAS:** This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Weedon G. Parris, a native of Barbados and long time Cambridge resident; and
- WHEREAS:** Weedon immigrated to the United States in 1923 and later married Mildred (Taylor) in 1930, a marriage which blessed them with two sons, Arthur C., long time Chairman of the Cambridge Planning Board, and Weedon, Jr., of Hudson, Massachusetts; and
- WHEREAS:** Weedon was employed by Lever Brothers from 1923 to 1962 and by the New England Baptist Hospital from 1962 to his retirement in 1971 completing forty-eight years in the work force; and
- WHEREAS:** Weedon had long been active in civic and religious events, serving as a member of the Riverside Neighborhood Association and Planning Team as well as serving as Vice-President of the Cambridge Economic Opportunity Committee from 1968 to 1970; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Mildred Parris and to the entire family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family on behalf of the entire City Council.

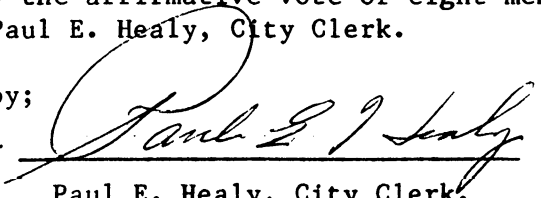
