To the Honorable City Councillors:

Dear Councillors,

Last year you asked for citizen participation for the Kendall Square site. I responded to the call as a representative of Area 4 Planning Team. Now I'm asking you to come to my aid and respond to a citizen's call for a grand jury investigation into the criminal conspiracy of the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority. In the packet of information that I gave you, you'll read such things as a Board member of the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority (on March 13) states that the "Cambridge Redevelopment Authority is out to get me out of the City." If this is the way to encourage citizen participation in this City, then you the Councillors are asking us the citizens to stand by and be thrown out of our City. In the packet I gave you, you'll see that a citizen took a stand against the Authority and the Authority took away his home and tried to force him out of the City. Because of my right to respond to the order of the City Councillor, I must come to you and ask that my right as a citizen be protected against the C.R.A.'s abuse of public trust and public funds. I don't think driving people out of the City is the policy of the Council when a person participates in his City government.

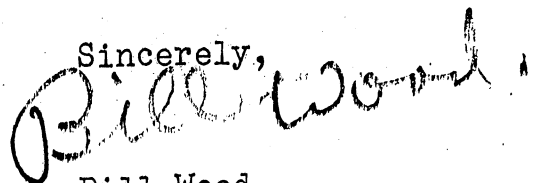
There is only so much investigation one person can do. There are some questions that still need to be answered, such as:

1. When does Chapter 268A of the Conduct of Public Officials and Employees apply?
2. What's the role of the University Trust, Garden City Bank and the Charles Trust play in the City?
3. Why should a life long resident of Cambridge be pushed out of the City?

I request a hearing with whatever City people are needed to start the ball rolling for a grand jury investigation into this matter of the C.R.A. While this is happening you should stop the C.R.A. from evicting me from my City. I am also asking for a choice in Legal Council with the cost up to \$10,000 picked up by the City of Cambridge.

I feel that I have participated by your order and am being removed from the City for doing what I felt was morally and legally right. You have a moral and legal obligation to me to protect my rights. Thank you.
