WHEREAS: On Friday, June 18, 1982, we heard of the passing of Robert W. Bright, a long time resident of Cambridge and in his retirement years of Mashpee, Massachusetts, and a very active gentleman in the affairs of Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: Robert W. Bright served his City and his neighborhood so well, in so many capacities, including Charter Membership and later Chairmanship of the Wellington-Harrington Citizens Committee that designed and then implemented a neighborhood stabilization program in a large, residential district of the City; Treasurer, Board Member and later Chairman of the Board of the Boston Branch N.A.A.C.P.; Chairman of the Cambridge Civic Unity Committee, Board Member of the Cambridge Community Center, Board Member of the Wellington-Harrington Development Corporation and member of the Cambridge Auxiliary Police Association and

WHEREAS: Robert W. Bright served his country and the labor movement so well, including service in the United States Air Force in World War II, an employee of the United States Post Office Department at the State House in Boston, Massachusetts Member, Local 51-100, Postal Worker's Union, AFL-CIO; and past President, National Alliance of Post Office Employees; and

WHEREAS: Anne Brooks Bright, his beloved and devoted wife, encouraged and supported him in all of these endeavors in the City and in the community over the years, in the efforts to improve housing, racial conditions, neighborhood conditions and opportunities for youth; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our heartfelt sorrow to his beloved wife for the loss of her beloved husband and to his friends and associates for the loss of a beloved friend; and be it further

RESOLVED: That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to Anne Brooks Bright as a permanent remembrance to her by this City Council.
