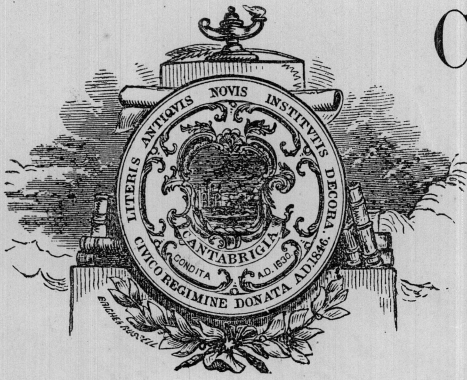




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

May 29, 1873.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Mead Street

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land
in width between

forty feet

Cogswell Avenue And Walden St.

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

Barbour And Hodges, dated April 19, 1873.

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *and*
that thirty days be allowed for the re-
moval of fences or other obstructions standing
thereon
