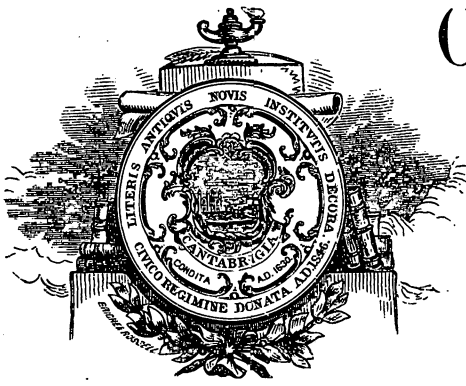




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE. 15

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Dec. 28, 1874.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Kimmaird Street
between *Putnam Avenue* and a point near *Bay St.*
should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *thirty five feet*
in width between *Putnam Avenue* and a point near *Bay St.*

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

J. G. Chase City Engineer

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. And
that *three months* be allowed for the removal
of all obstructions standing thereon.
