At the suggestion of Mary Samps, I am writing to you to apply for a position on the Council for the Aging Board when an opening arises as described in the Cambridge Chronicle.

I am 69 years of age, semi-retired and own my home where we have lived for the past 43 years. My educational background consists of a B.S. degree from M.I.T. - '39 and an M.B.A. degree from Harvard Business School - '41. Before taking early retirement in 1979, I was the Controller for the Combined Jewish Philanthropies of Greater Boston, Inc. for 22 years. Among my many duties was the responsibility for the entire budgeting process of Jewish Community Housing for the Elderly - over 1000 units in Brighton & Newton, sponsored by the Combined Jewish Philanthropies and financed by HUD.

From 1943 when I first moved to Cambridge to 1963 I was very active in Cambridge affairs - both City affairs and those of the Jewish community. As president of the Jewish Community Center I was deeply involved in elders' activities as well as children's and those of the general community. Appointed by the City Manager, I served on the Civic Unity Committee for five years. I was President of the Agassiz School P.T.A. for three years and Vice-President of the Association of P.T.A.'s for a similar period.

From 1954 to 1962 I was a candidate for School Committee on the slate of the Cambridge Civic Association. I also took an active part in several other committees of the CCA.

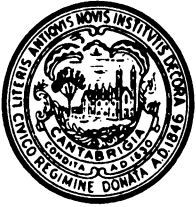


