

Cambridge March 2^d 1870
The Committee on Roads and Bridges
would respectfully

Report: That Bridge
Street, from its junction with Cambridge
Street to Canal Bridge, should be
widened on the southerly side, so as to
make said street seventy five feet in
width: and that for this purpose it
is necessary to take and lay out as
a public street or way certain parcels
of land belonging to the persons
hereinafter named, and shown on a plan
drawn by the City Engineer dated
February 16th 1870, viz.

A parcel of land belonging to
Hastings Heirs and Dana, and containing
Seventysix (76) square feet; the value of
which is estimated to be \$95.00

A parcel of land belonging to
S. A. Davis containing Fifteen hundred
sixtyone (1561) square feet the value
of which is estimated to be \$2,575.65

A parcel of land belonging to
Munroe Heirs containing Fifteen
hundred fortyfive (1545) square feet
the value of which is estimated to be \$1,931.25

feet, the value of which is
estimated to be \$3,380.00

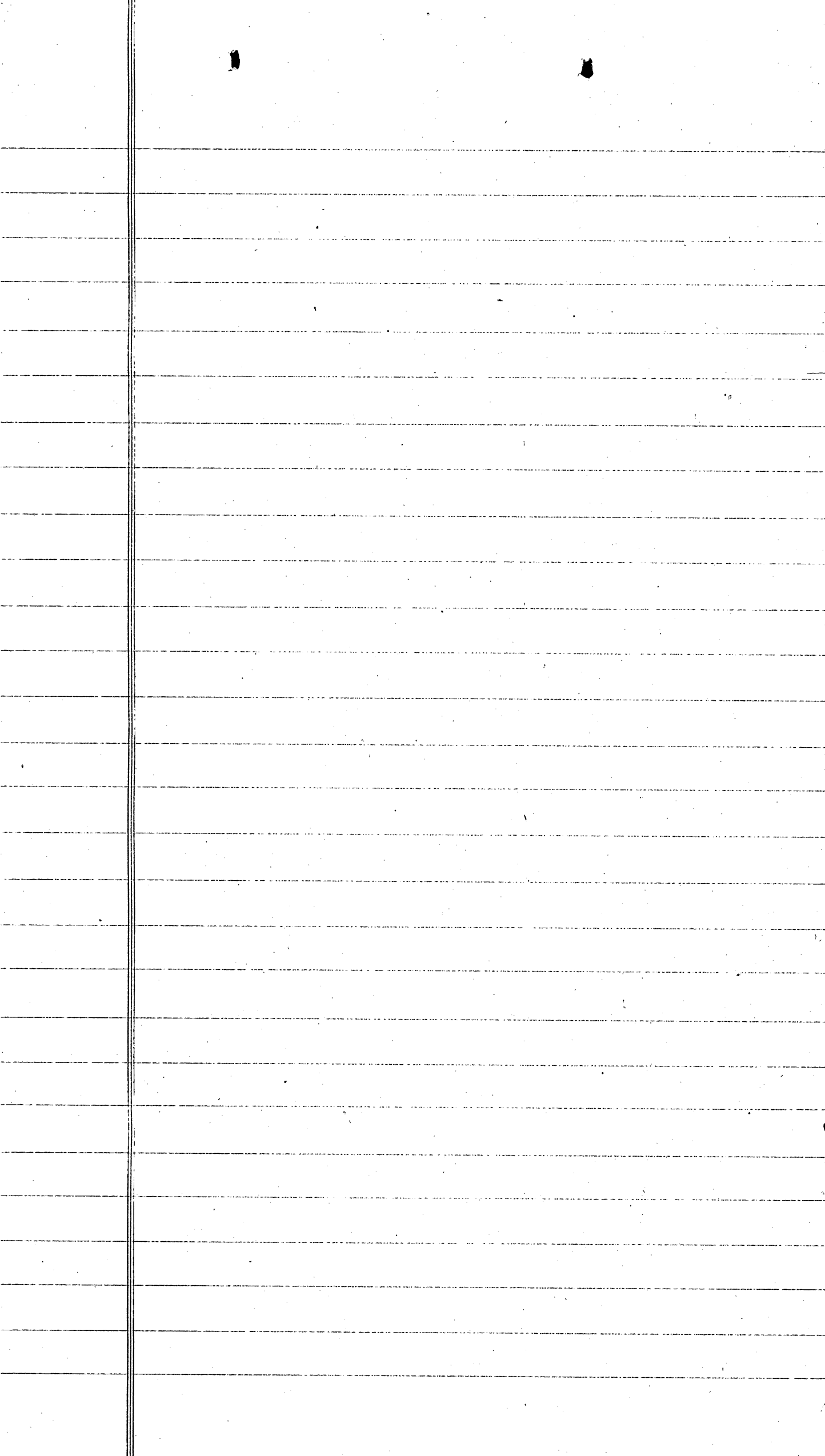
