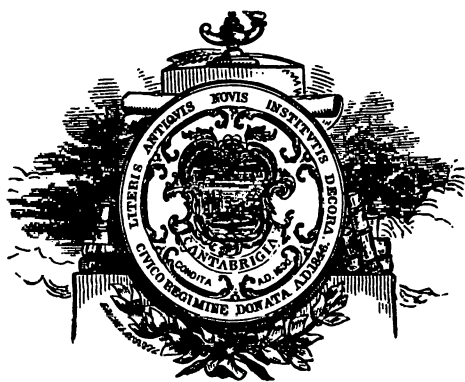




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Nov. 1882.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

*Bristol Street, so-called,
between Webster Avenue and Portland Street*

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *Forty feet*
in width between *Webster Avenue* and
Portland Street,

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *W. A. Mason & Son,*
Engineers, dated June 1882,

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid,
