- WHEREAS: Associated offers parents services they can afford because they pay a fee based on their income and family size. Assistance from public and private sources comprises the balance; and
- WHEREAS: The assistance comes through one of its annual fundraisers, JAZZ IT UP!; and
- WHEREAS: JAZZ IT UP! is a fun filled night of celebration, fun, food and friends; and
- WHEREAS: This annual fundraiser will be held on April 11, 2003 at the Charles Hotel in Harvard Square beginning at 6:00 p.m.; now therefore be it
