In Common Council, May 22. 1861-

Ordered,

That the Superintendent of Streets, under the direction of the Surveyors of Highways, be authorized, in addition to the repairs heretofore directed to be made on the Cambridge side of the Green Bridge, to make repairs upon the Brighton side of said Bridge, the same to be made ^{by him} under the permission granted by the Selectmen of Brighton, and as the Agent of said Town of Brighton; the City not hereby admitting ^{any} ~~any~~ liability to obligation to make repairs in the Town of Brighton, nor any liability for defects in that part of the Bridge lying in said Town, and not meaning to withdraw the notice heretofore given to the Town of Brighton that the City will make no repairs on the Brighton side of said Bridge, nor to incur any liability by making such repairs, at the request and on behalf of said Town, by permission of its Selectmen.
