In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 143, General Laws, Sections 6, 7, 8 and 9, an inspection was made of the above named premises reported as dangerous and unsafe. Persons having an interest therein were notified. No effort has been made on their part to rectify conditions.

The public safety requires that these dangerous and unsafe structures be taken down at once, and I respectfully request permission through Order of the City Council to immediately enter on the premises and take same down without delay. The costs and charges incurred shall constitute a lien on the land, and shall be enforced as provided in the same manner as the collection of taxes on land.

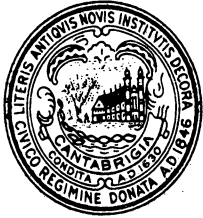
