- WHEREAS: The people of Yatabe, the leading municipality in the new Tsukuba Science City, that is located thirty miles northeast of Tokyo, are desirous of establishing a sister city relationship with Cambridge, Massachusetts, whose citizens also desire a Sister City relationship with Yatabe and so propose to the Cambridge City Council; and
- WHEREAS: Tsukuba City is the site of Japan's new science city emphasizing the same academic and scientific excellence as has been the tradition of Cambridge throughout its history; and
- WHEREAS: Tsukuba City has two national universities, forty-two national laboratories and several private institutions, and
- WHEREAS: The International Exposition of Science is to be held in Yatabe Municipality of Tsukuba City from March 17 to September 16, in 1985, where over 30 million visitors from all over the world will be in attendance; and
- WHEREAS: The emphasis of this Exposition is to cultivate the growth of international science and technology in harmony with human beings, dwellings, and natural surroundings. This will give us as partners an opportunity to make an indepth assessment of the future of the world and a chance to consider the earth's limits and the international cooperation needed for the coming 21st Century; and
- WHEREAS: Several visiting scientists from Tsukuba have received training in their fields as research staff at M.I.T. in years past, and there is presently an exchange program; and
- WHEREAS: Outcomes of such a proposal would include cultural exchanges, educational services, visiting student exchanges, shared scientific projects, economic industrial cooperation, and promotion of a joint spirit of friendship and cooperation between the two of the leading scientific centers of the world, and now therefore be it:
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record as establishing a Sister Cityship with the city of Yatabe, Tsukuba Science City, Japan. The City Clerk is hereby requested to forward a suitable engrossed copy of this resolution to the Cambridge-Yatabe, Tsukuba Science Sister-City Steering Committee.

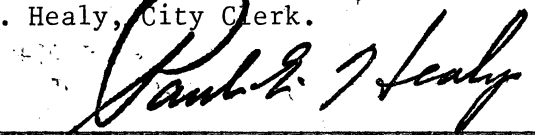
