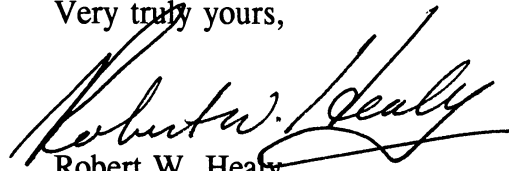

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$35,000.00 to the Community Development Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to fund additional environmental and public health consulting services to further address environmental concerns associated with the WR Grace site. These services to be performed by Dr. John Spengler of Environmental Health & Engineering and the Harvard School of Public Health include preparation of a scope for testing of Russell Field, preparation of a scope for environmental testing by the MBTA, response to the requests for additional information from the City Council's Environmental Committee, and technical review of WR Grace's application for a Permit to Proceed with Response Actions filed with DEP this month. This work is critical to the City's continuing efforts to ensure that environmental concerns are adequately understood and properly addressed. This appropriation will be funded from free cash.
