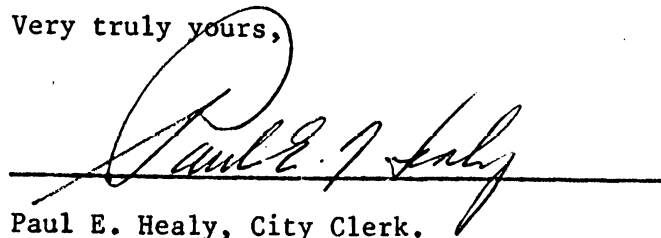

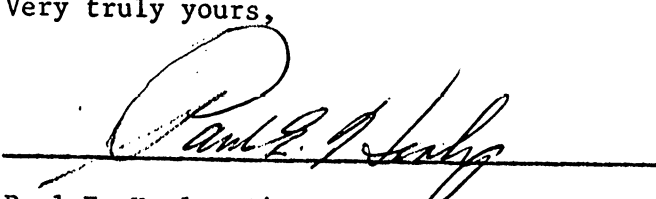

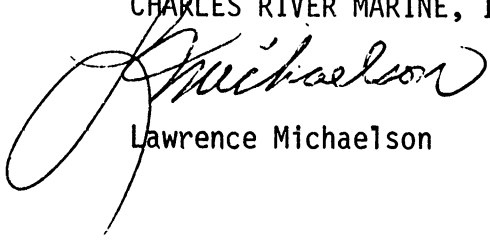
Gentlemen:
