WHEREAS: Citizens have consistently raised concerns about speeding on Pearl Street which have been addressed to the Traffic and Police Departments; and

WHEREAS: There was last week an accident involving a school bus at the intersection of Pearl Street and Allston Street; and

WHEREAS: The Traffic Department has committed to initial a request with the state for a reduction in the speed limit from thirty miles per hour to twenty-five miles per hours; and

WHEREAS: It is imperative through actions that the Traffic Department is taking, and through enforcement of traffic laws by the Police Department that safety for cars and pedestrians be increased; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and is hereby requested to ensure that the City Council receives consistent reports from the Traffic Department with regard to its process with the state; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and is hereby requested to direct the Traffic Department to conduct a traffic study at the intersection of Pearl Street and Allston Street and take steps to improve the safety at this intersection.
